The special Friday night line-up is back for a fourth year with an uproarious comedy, a world-premiere concert, and more. So, tune in, watch online, and enjoy your front-row seat to Broadway's best!

We begin on a comedic high note with **One Man, Two Guvvorns** (Fri 6th, 9 p.m.). Featuring a hilarious Tony Award-winning performance by CBS *Late Late Show* host and self-proclaimed Broadway superfan James Corden, the



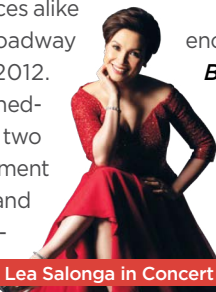

pratfalls performed masterfully by the sidesplittingly funny Corden.

What makes *Fiddler on the Roof* so timeless? Find out in **Fiddler: A Miracle of Miracles** (Fri 13th, 9 p.m.), the first in-depth documentary on the beloved musical. Composer Jerry Bock and lyricist Sheldon Harnick are among those sharing stories and insights into the show's deep reach across time and cultures, along with famous fans Lin-Manuel Miranda, Topol, Joel Grey, Harvey Fierstein, and cast members from the 2015 Broadway revival including Danny Burstein, Jessica Hecht, and Alexandra Silber.

Highlights include footage of a 1969 Brooklyn middle school production featuring a predominantly African American and Hispanic cast, recent productions in Thailand and Japan, the Temptations performing "If I Were a Rich Man," and reflections on director and choreographer Jerome Robbins' famed "Bottle Dance."

Get in the holiday spirit with a special encore of **Irving Berlin's Holiday Inn—The Broadway Musical** (Fri 20th, 9 p.m.), Roundabout Theatre Company's Tony-nominated musical packed with thrilling dance numbers and a parade of hit Irving Berlin songs, including "White Christmas," "Easter Parade," and "Shaking the Blues Away."

**Lea Salonga in Concert** (Fri 27th, 9 p.m.) showcases the celebrated singer and Broadway star in a sold-out concert at the Sydney Opera House. Internationally famous for her powerhouse voice and perfect pitch, Salonga burst onto the Broadway musical scene with her 1991 Tony-winning performance in *Miss Saigon*. The first Asian to play Eponine in *Les Misérables* on Broadway, she returned to the beloved show as Fantine in the 2006 revival. She received rave reviews in the 2017 revival of *Once on This Island*, and wowed audiences in *Les Misérables 25th Anniversary Concert at the O2* (which you can enjoy Sat 28th, 8:30 p.m. on THIRTEEN).

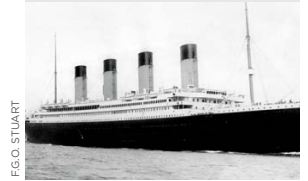
